Crisis Stabilization Unit Centers and Crisis Residential Treatment Centers

The **Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU)** centers serve San Bernardino County Residents, ages 13 and over who are experiencing a crisis. These voluntary 20-chair facilities, provide a home-like setting designed to provide additional access points to receive recovery-based treatment options, interventions and stabilization services in the least restrictive manner possible in their community for up to 23 hour stays.

Referrals may be generated by local law enforcement/emergency responders, hospital emergency and medical departments, San Bernardino County Department of Behavioral Health (DBH) Community Crisis Response Teams, DBH programs, outpatient clinics, individuals and families.

The **Crisis Residential Treatment (CRT)** centers are voluntary 16-bed centers providing services to San Bernardino County residents' ages 18 - 59 for up to 90 days. Providing a home-like setting designed to provide short term, recovery based treatment options, services and interventions for people experiencing a serious psychiatric crisis. This center will allow residents to practice real-world recovery by participating in the day-to-day activities of running a household, including learning basic living skills, social/interpersonal skills.

Referrals may be generated by hospital emergency and medical departments, San Bernardino County Department of Behavioral Health Community Response Teams, DBH programs and outpatient clinics, individuals and families.

Los centros proporcionan una configuración hogareña diseñada para brindar opciones de tratamiento, servicios e intervenciones a corto plazo para la recuperación de personas que experimentan una crisis psiquiátrica grave. Este centro permitirá a los residentes practicar la recuperación real participando en las actividades diarias de administrar un hogar, incluyendo el aprendizaje de habilidades básicas para la vida, habilidades sociales/interpersonales.
